

Light and electricity in the tunnel of the Visp south bypass

The Office for National Road Construction of the Canton of Valais is currently building the 31.8 km motorway section of the A9 between Visp and Siere. This includes the 8.8 km south bypass, 7 km of which runs through tunnels. In addition to the existing Vispental tunnel, which is being completely renovated with respect to the operational and safety equipment, the 4.5 km Eyholz tunnel, and the 2.6 km Visp tunnel are also being built. All are double-lane, 2-tube tunnels.

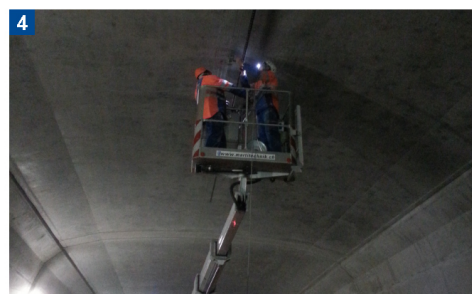
